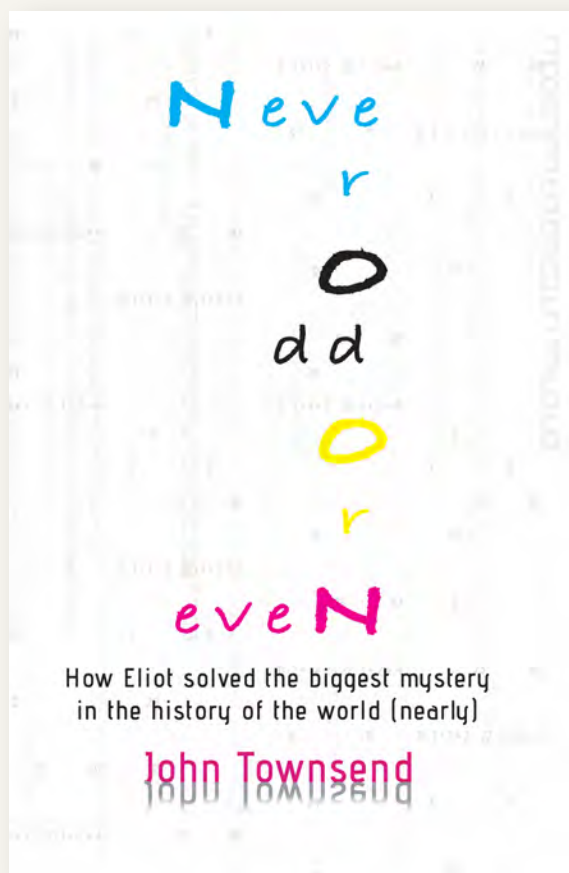
ABOUT THE AUTHOR

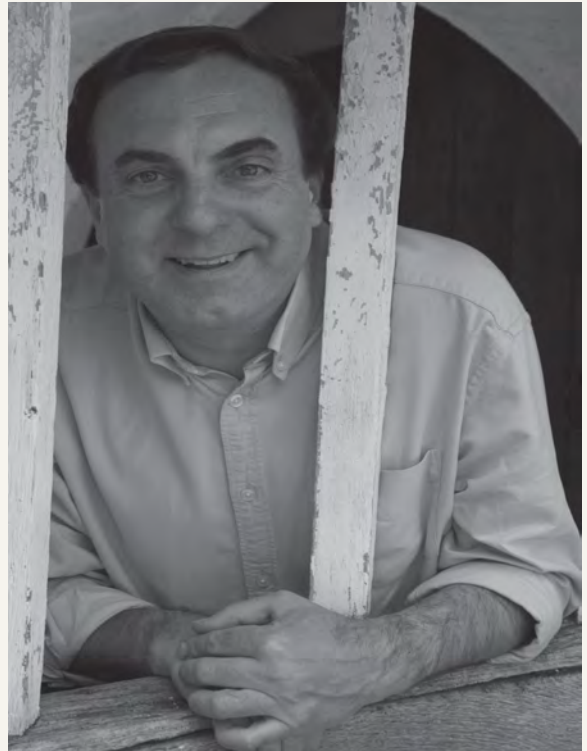

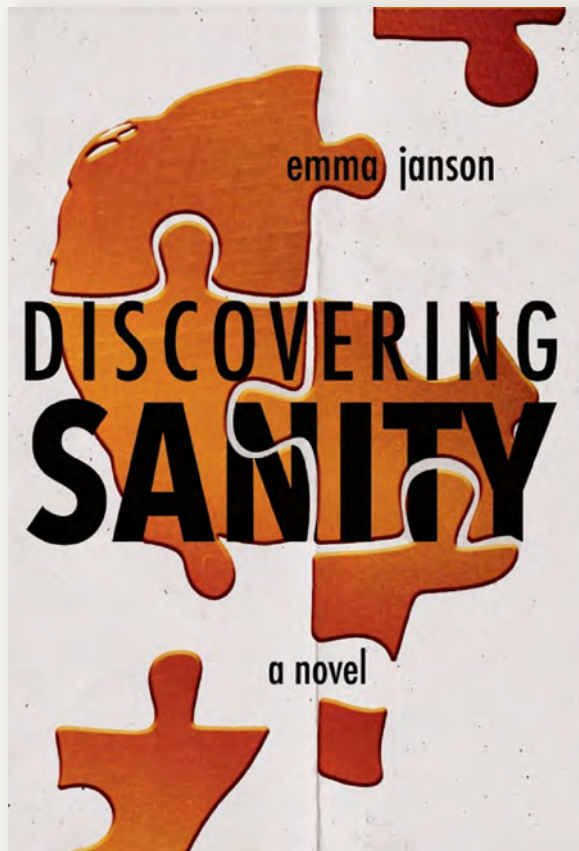
John Townsend was born in Chelmsford, Essex, and discovered his enchantment with books at an early age.

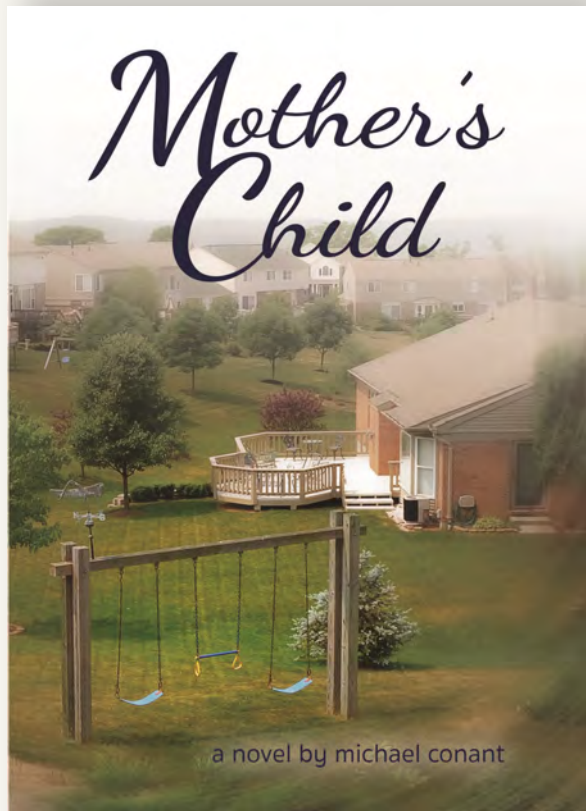
ABOUT THE AUTHOR

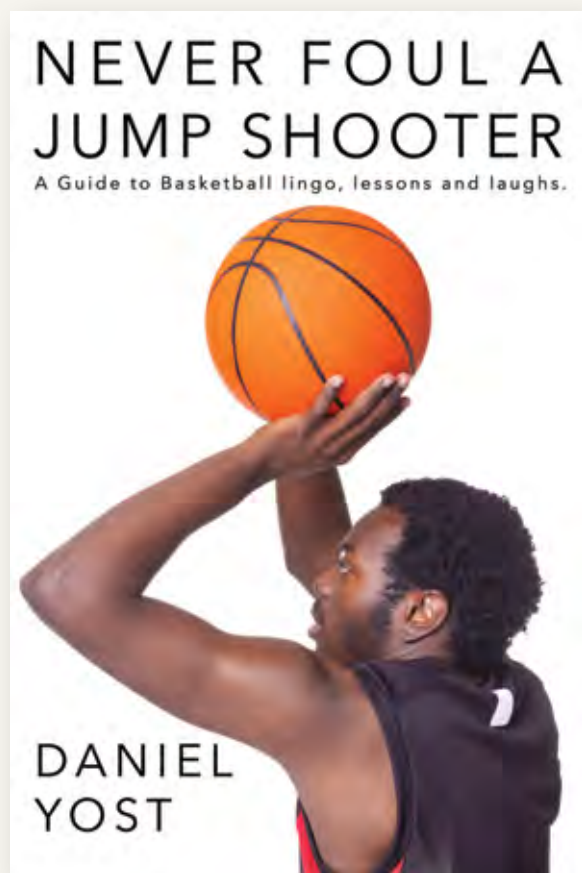

ABOUT THE AUTHOR

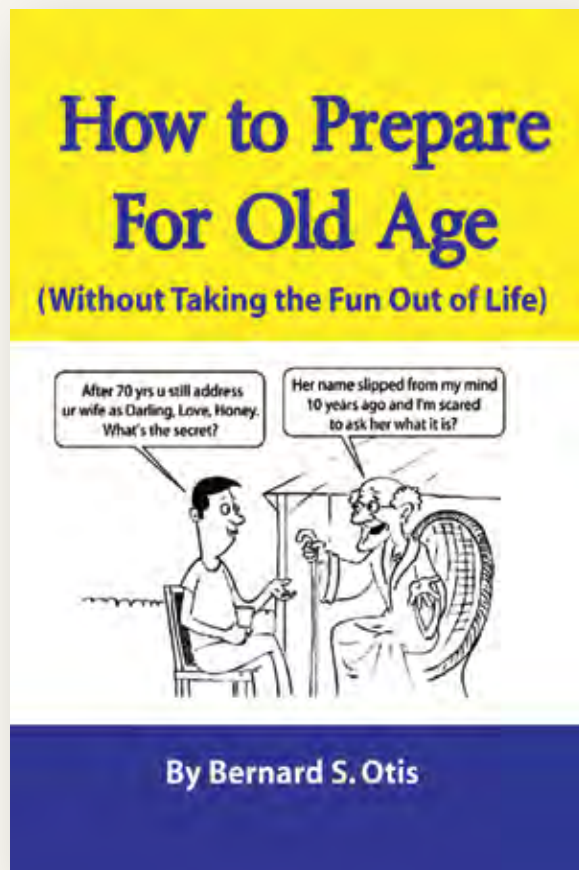
